The Knoxville Museum of Art's Summer Art Academy offers quality educational opportunities that will ignite your child's imagination through drawing, painting, sculpture, and more!

Each week offers a new and exciting age-appropriate art class that will inspire and challenge your child. The KMA's certified art educators provide personalized instruction in small groups. Each class is held at the Knoxville Museum of Art and runs for five consecutive days, Monday through Friday. Morning classes are offered each week for children ages 5-12 and afternoon classes are offered for teens 13 and up. Classes start Monday, June 6, and continue through Friday, July 29. Tuition for the half-day class (unless otherwise specified) is \$130.00 for KMA members and \$145.00 for non-members and includes workshop supplies, instruction, and gallery activities.

LET'S PAINT

JUMP START: EXPLORING ART

Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

\$130 Members/\$145 Non-members

This class introduces students to a variety of art forms as they practice drawing and painting. Students activate their imaginations and creatively express themselves while gaining developmentally appropriate skills.

ACTION PAINTING

Ages 7-9 • 9am-12pm

\$130 Members/\$145 Non-members

Students will let loose in this action-oriented class, experimenting with motion and movement while creating beautiful 2D paintings.

HISTORY OF EAST TENNESSEE'S ARTISTS

Ages 10-12 • 9am-12pm

Students will look back in time to discover works of art from East Tennessee, visiting the galleries to learn about Catherine Wiley, Charles Krutch, and Beauford Delaney, while creating their own still lifes, portraits, or landscapes.

PAINTING METHODS

Ages 13 and up • 1-4pm

In this class, students explore the various ways of applying paint to a canvas. Each class focuses on one specific technique, such as stippling, blending, dry brush, scumbling, and sgraffito.

DOING ART DIFFERENTLY

JUMP START: LEARNING TENNESSEE'S STATE SYMBOLS

Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

In this class, students will learn to identify Tennessee's state flag, state tree, state flower, and more - and use them to inspire their own artworks.

WEAVING & PAINTING

Ages 7-9 • 9am-12pm

Students will combine painting and weaving to create a painted tapestry - using scraps of felt fabric, ribbons, yarn, canvas, and string.

NO PAINTBRUSHES ALLOWED!

Ages 10-12 • 9am-12pm

Students will paint a self-portrait, without a brush, using only their fingers.

STICK DRAWINGS

Ages 13-Up • 1-4pm

In this class, students are going to lose control and draw with very long sticks. This method of mark-making can be traced back to Henri Matisse. Each day will present a different challenge, but each drawing must include value, expressive lines, and a balanced composition.

JUST A LITTLE SCIENCE

JUMP START: POSITIONS OF THE SUN AND THE PHASES OF THE MOON

Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

Students will learn the different positions of the sun and the phases of the moon.

THE COLORS OF THE REEF

A coral reef is an underwater ecosystem teeming with life. Students will learn about coral reefs and create a miniature underwater scene. A reef has an abundance of colors, shapes, and textures to explore.

MIXING IT UP

JUMP START: COLOR THE SEASONS

Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

Students will learn about the four seasons, spring, summer, autumn, and winter. In addition, students will learn why time changes and how to predict the changes in the seasons.

MONOTYPES

Ages 7-9 • 9am-12pm

Students will explore techniques, effects, and subject matter to create layered and unique monotype prints.

BATIK (BAH-TEAK)

Students will practice the craft of batik and textile arts, creating beautiful designs with wax and then adding various dyes to the fabric.

PAINTING ON LOCATION (PLEIN-AIR)

Ages 13 and up • 1-4pm

Discover ways to produce art by exploring a variety of techniques from sketches to contemporary paintings. Explore the museum galleries while sketching art works and get your creativity flowing with plein-air painting.

JULY 11- 22 | TWO WEEK CLASS

SILHOUETTES

Ages 13 and up • 1-4pm

Discover the art of silhouettes working with paper, inks, colored pencils, and cutting techniques. Using the work of Kara Walker and Peter Callesen as inspiration, students will create 2D compositions and 3D shadowboxes that express their own ideas in silhouette.

WATERCOLOR AND CLEAR GLUE

JELLYFISH

JULY 6 • Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

Students design a jellyfish, making sure to take up the entire paper with the body and tentacles, and trace over their design with clear glue. Once the glue is dry, students color in their jellyfish using watercolors.

NORTHERN LIGHTS CHALK PICTURE

JULY 7 • Ages 7-9 • 9am-12pm

Students will learn about the northern lights, why they occur, where they occur, and make a night sky full of aurora borealis using chalk and a template of their own.

YAYOI KUSAMA INSPIRED

DOT PAINTING

JULY 8 • Ages 10-12 • 9am-12pm

Students are introduced to Yayoi Kusama's dot paintings. Students will learn about Kusama and talk about her work and technique. NO PAINTING. Just dots (using pencil erasers for dots)!

CLAY, PRINTS, AND SILHOUETTES

JUMP START: LOOKING AT DIFFERENT CULTURES THROUGH CLAY

Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

Students will learn about different cultures as they create a clay Native American Story Necklace, Pueblo Pot, and a Mexicana Tona Animal Mask.

TEXTURE BOXES

PRINT MAKING: INTAGLIO

PRINTMAKING

Ages 10-12 • 9am-12pm

Students will learn intaglio printing, a printmaking process in which ink is below the surface of the plate. Students will scratch or etch into the printing surface or plate, which is copper, zinc, aluminum, magnesium, plastics, or even coated paper.

Students will explore the design principle of pattern through the creation of a repeat shape relief print.
