Each week offers a new and exciting age-appropriate art class that will inspire and challenge your child. The KMA's certified art educators provide instruction in small groups with personalized attention. Classes are held at the Knoxville Museum of Art. Morning classes are offered each week for children ages 3-12 and Afternoon classes are offered for teens 13 and up. Classes start Monday, June 3, and continue each week through Friday, July 26. Tuition for the half-day class is \$160.00 for KMA members and \$175.00 for non-members (unless specified otherwise), and includes workshop supplies, instruction, and gallery activities.

### **Functional Forms**

#### JUMP START: LITTLE MAKERS Ages 3-4 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members A great way to introduce young artists to the sculptural elements of form and shape. Students will be introduced to Model Magic and age-appropriate sculptural materials to create the flora and fauna observed in the KMA sculpture garden.

#### PINCH POT PLANTERS Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

*\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members* Students will learn the sculptural technique of creating pinch pot planters. Students will make garden tile markers and a seed starter journal to track the entire journey.

#### RELIEF STORYTELLING Ages 7-9 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Stone or clay relief tiles have been used to give information and tell stories throughout history. Students will learn how to tell a story in one image by creating high and low relief tiles. Forms will be created by carving away or adding clay to slab rolled tiles to bring their stories to life.

## **Making Multiples**

#### JUMP START: LITTLE MAKERS Ages 3-4 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members This is an introductory printmaking class that will explore multiple ways to create a print without using a press.

#### FOUND OBJECT PRINTMAKING Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Collagraph printmaking turns everyday textures, patterns, and objects into bright unique images. Students will make landscape compositions by gathering found materials to create a portfolio of prints that will explore texture and color in this hands-on tactile and fun class.

#### SIGN AT THE BOTTOM! Ages 7-9 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will learn the basic principles of printmaking to create a portfolio of multiblock relief prints and signature stamps using linocut, collage, woodcut, and more!

#### SILK SCREEN SELFIE Ages 10-12 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will learn the principles of color mixing and image layering through the process of silkscreen. Each student will create a self-portrait in the pop art style and learn how to turn simple images into bold colorful works of art.

#### PRINTED FASHIONS Ages 13 & up • 1pm-4pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will use printmaking processes such as screen printing and linocut to transform clothes into wearable art. Each student will develop designs and images to be printed on shirts and bandanas.



## Renewed and Recycled Art

#### UNDER THE SEA Ages 3-4 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will learn about some of the flora and fauna that live in our oceans and use recycled objects to create mixed media sea creatures.

## ECO FRIENDLY CITY

#### Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will design and make a futuristic city. This city will be made of found and recycled packaging and explore new ways of making large sculptural designs.

## REIMAGINING THE MINIATURE THORNE ROOMS

Ages 7-9 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will take a field trip to the Knoxville Museum of Art's Thorne Room collection and create their own personal space tableau box. The elements of each room will include recycled material as well as 2-D collages.

#### STEAMPUNK BUGS Ages 10-12 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will create a futuristic insect specimen using clay, discarded metal pieces, and wire. Make an air-dry clay body, push wire legs, antennae, and steampunk embellishments.

#### UPCYCLED INSPIRATIONS Ages 13 & up • 1pm-4pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will learn basic mending and sewing techniques to upcycle and reinvent clothing. Each student will create a fashion design and bring it to life using multiple processes in order to make a new garment out of something old.

### **Draw Me a Story**

#### JUMPSTART: LITTLE MAKERS Ages 3-4 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members This is a great way to introduce young artists to the wide world of 2-D art. Students experiment with multiple materials and techniques to tell a story through images.

#### COMICS 101 Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will create autobiographical three panel comics while developing basic drawing skills. The comics will use a variety of drawing materials such as pencils, pens, stencils, and ink.

#### MAKE EM' LAUGH Ages 7-9 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Learn about different kinds of story-telling through comics. Students will expand their drawing skills by using a mix of imagination and observation to create an edition of comic books to be shared with classmates.

#### THE FUNNY PAGES Ages 10-12 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Each student will design and create one large newspaper "Funny Page" that combines multiple drawing techniques and individual comic strips. The drawing techniques will focus on using pencil, pen, and ink to create light, shadow, texture, and detail in order to bring the comics to life.

#### ZINES AND INDEPENDENT PUBLISHING Ages 13 & up • 1pm-4pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will learn how to make small scale magazines and books, known as Zines, which are often a mix of photographic collage, writing, drawing, and more. The class will teach students how to put together a zine on a topic of their choosing to be distributed to their friends and classmates.

## **One Day Classes**

#### JULY 1: FLOWER PRESSING Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

\$40 Members/\$50 Non-members Learn how to press flowers in order to make a set of cards, bookmarks, mobiles, and more.

#### JULY 2 AND JULY 9: KAREN LAMONTE SCULPTURAL GARMENT (TWO PARTS) Ages 7-9 • 9am-12pm

\$80 Members/\$90 Non-members Create a free standing sculptural garment inspired by the Karen Lamonte sculptures in the KMA collection. Drape and fold clay in order to create your desired shape and use stamps or tools to create a pattern. Once the statue is fired, on July 9 students will return and complete with a Patina Finish.

#### JULY 3: BOOKBINDING Ages 10-12 • 9am-12pm

\$40 Members/\$50 Non-Members Learn several kinds of bookbinding in order to make your own unique journal, sketchbook, or artist book.

## JULY 8-12 Clay Week 2.0

#### JUMP START: LITTLE MAKERS Ages 3-4 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Young artists will learn about the basic art principles of form and shape. Students will explore the KMA sculpture garden to create a garden of their own filled with flora and fauna. Students will be introduced to Model Magic and ageappropriate drawing skills.

#### PINCH POT PLANTERS Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will learn the sculptural technique of creating pinch pot planters. Students will make garden tile markers and a seed starter journal to track the entire journey.

#### RELIEF STORYTELLING Ages 7-9 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Stone or clay relief tiles have been used to give information and tell stories throughout history. Wobbly mugs, bumpy plates, and misshapen butter dishes are just a few examples of perfectly imperfect ceramic pieces that will be created for use or display.

## **Art in Motion**

#### MAKE IT MOVE! Ages 3-4 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will make abstract art that includes an element of movement in the making; rolling, shaking, spinning. If you can make it move, you can make it art.

#### WIND POWERED Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will create sculptural wind chimes and mobiles using recycled materials, wire work, and collage. Each sculpture will make a different kind of sound or movement in the breeze and students will learn how to use the natural elements as a part of their sculpture.

#### MARIONETTE PUPPETS Ages 7-9 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will learn several techniques for making marionette puppets with different ranges of mobility. The class will write a story together to be performed by their puppets on the last day of class.

#### MAKING FACES Ages 10-12 • 9am-12pm

*\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members* In this class, students will construct wearable masks that take inspiration from theatrical performances. Students will design and construct masks that create a total transformation of the wearer.



## JULY 22-26 Collaborative Greation

#### MUSEUM MAKERS Ages 3-4 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Explore the collection at the KMA! Our young artists will work together to create art that is inspired by works in the Higher Ground exhibition. They will explore multiple kinds of art making techniques and materials to turn the classroom into a museum exhibition.

#### PORTRAIT GALLERY Ages 5-6 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will use 2-D art making techniques to make representational and abstract portraits of their classmates as well as large-scale self-portraits.

#### STEAMPUNK BUGS Ages 7-9 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students will create a futuristic insect specimen using clay, discarded metal pieces, and wire. Make an air-dry clay body, push wire legs, antennae, and steampunk embellishments. Students will work together to create unified mobiles of their bugs in flight.

#### FABRIC TESSELLATION Ages 10-12 • 9am-12pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members Students learn about pattern and color theory to create wall hangings inspired by quilting and weaving traditions. In addition to their own wall hangings, the class must work together to create one larger piece to be displayed on the last day of class.

#### PAINTING SELF-PORTRAITS Ages 13 & up • 1pm-4pm

\$160 Members/\$175 Non-Members This class will focus on observation based techniques for constructing a self-portrait painting. Students will learn about underpainting, color theory, and figure proportioning in order to make selfportraits from life and from photographs.
